Module 3: Turning in Your Scholar's Work



Method 1: Google Forms

- Will be assigned by your child's teacher and will be located in your child's Google Classroom (assigned by their teacher)
- Works best for multiple choice but can be used for short answer or a paragraph
- Will be 'turned-in' once your scholar finishes the assignment and clicks 'submit'
- Not as practical for math (doesn't show the 'work')



Method 2: Asynchronous Video

- Parents/guardians video their scholar performing the task
- Use whatever method you prefer (MUST be able to upload to Google Classroom)
- Upload to your scholar's Google classroom.



Method 3: Synchronous Video

- Similar to asynchronous video method except this is 'live' via a Zoom connection
- Teacher will send out Zoom times and link
- No need to download/install Zoom*

Method 4: Upload picture/PDF

- Snap picture with a smartphone (convert to PDF if you can)
- Upload to your scholar's Google classroom



Using your iPhone to make a PDF

- Apple (iOS)
 - Set the option in the Notes app
 - Open Notes
 - Tap 'New note'
 - Tap camera button at top
 - Tap 'Scan Documents'
 - Tap shutter button if it doesn't start automatically; take as many 'snaps' (pages) as you want
 - Tap 'Save' after you've scanned all that you need to (button will show how many)
 - Scanned pages will be in a new note in the Notes app
