

Student and Staff Face Coverings: A Visual Guide

While masks are not required, if you chose to wear one, it must conform to the following visual guidelines.

Face coverings may be solid color or patterned but must be without verbal or visual symbolism or reference to elements of popular culture including decorative brand logos.

- 1. No symbols. Examples: no USA or Texas flag, no peace symbol.
- 2. **No popular culture**: cartoon images, or brand logos. Examples: college/pro sports, cartoon characters, fashion/brand logos or tags, the yellow smiley face, rainbows and unicorns.
- 3. **No messages:** no words, slogans, statements of any content. **EXCEPTIONS:** Great Hearts branded face coverings; individuals' names for identification purposes

Patterns may be entirely abstract, or they may include tasteful, decorative (non-cartoonish) representations of things like leaves, flowers, etc.
